





AMERICAN HOBBY HORSE SERIES For Kids Who Love Horseless Horse Showing

A favorite at TIEC on Saturday nights in July and October, competitive hobby horsing originated in Finland and has more than 10,000 active participants around the globe. Open to any participants under the age of 14, all that's required for this horse-less sport is a hobby horse, a toy consisting of a stick with a horse head that participants "ride."

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Riders 4 to 14-years-old complete a course of jumps with their hobby horse, scored for time, and will incur one fault for every rail knocked down while on course. The top eight placing participants will be awarded ribbons for each division, and special awards will be given throughout the event.

DIVISIONS AVAILABLE:

Ages 6&U: Cross-rails; 18in. Ages 7-8: Cross-rails; 18in. Ages 9-11: 18in; 2ft. Ages 12-14: 2ft.; 2ft. 6in.

THE SPECTATOR'S GUIDE

To Equestrian Competition

HUNTER/JUMPER HORSE SHOWS

A Hunter/Jumper horse show is a three to five-day event made up of many mini-events that take place in the show rings each day, called classes. There are three main class categories: Show Jumpers, Hunters, and Equitation. Classes are further subdivided by rider age and experience level, skill of the horse, size or age of the horse or pony, etc., all of which determine what size and type of a fence the horses and riders will jump.



HUNTERS

Hunt seat competitions are based upon elegant traditions arising from the foxhunt. Hunters differ from Jumpers because they are judged on the style, movement, and technical proficiency of the horse and rider within the constraints of the set course design. Hunters should display jumping ability, manners, style, an even pace, and quality.



EQUITATION

Equitation competition is offered for junior and amateur riders and is judged based on the style and form of the rider. Horses are not judged in this discipline, but successful riders will ensure that their horses are well behaved. Riders can be judged over fences or on the flat.

GRAND PRIX SHOW JUMPING

Jumping is the best-known and is also one of the three Olympic equestrian sports, along with Dressage and Eventing. As in all equestrian sports, men and women compete on equal terms. The Olympic sport of Grand Prix Show Jumping is the highest and most challenging level of Jumping competition. Riders compete over a set course of obstacles as tall as 1.60 meters (5.25 feet) in height. They must clear all of the fences without knocking down a rail and within the time allowed in order to return for the second round, also known as the "jump-off," and be the fastest with the least faults to win.



GUIDE TO SHOW JUMPING SCORING

Penalties in Show Jumping competitions are referred to as "faults." Knocking down a rail or a pole on a jump is 4 faults, as is putting a foot in the water jump or the first refusal. In Table II jumper classes, falls and going offcourse result in elimination, as does a second refusal.

Show Jumping Faults and Penalties:

Knocking over a jump: 4 faults Refusing a jump: 4 faults Two refusals: Eliminated Rider falls off: Eliminated Over the time allowed: 1 fault for every second or portion there of over the time allowed.

CONCOURS DE SAUT INTERNATIONAL - CSI

CSI is the ranking system for Show Jumping. CSI is broken down into a starring system, the higher the prize money the higher number of stars: e.g. CSI 5* prize money is over \$300,000. CSI-W is a Show Jumping world cup competition.

DRESSAGE

Dressage is a competitive equestrian sport, defined by the Federation Equestrian International (FEI) as "the highest expression of horse training." The rider will be relaxed and appear effort-free while the horse willingly performs the requested movement. In modern Dressage competition, successful training at the various levels is demonstrated through the performance of "tests," which include a prescribed series of movements ridden within a standard arena. Dressage is considered the most artistic of the equestrian sports. The Freestyle is specially choreographed and performed to music.

CONCOURS DE DRESSAGE INTERNATIONAL-CDI

CDI notes the ranking system for Dressage with the same starring system as for Show Jumping.



PARA-DRESSAGE

Para-Dressage is conducted under the same basic rules as conventional Dressage, but with riders divided into different competition grades based on functional abilities There is no greater evidence of the incredible bond, trust and communication between horse and rider than in Para-Dressage. This Paralympic sport is a humbling reminder of the strength of the human spirit.



Eventing, one of the three Olympic equestrian disciplines, is a formidable combination of Dressage, Cross-Country, and Show Jumping, done over three days and with the same horse for each phase of competition. Often known as the triathlon of the equestrian world, Eventing is a sport that tests both the horse and rider in all aspects of horsemanship and athleticism.

Gladiator Polo[™] is a professional arena polo league that combines the world's best polo players with modified rules that keep the play fast. The event is played in a ring with all-weather footing approximately 1/10th of the dimensions of a typical grass polo field for an engaging and spectator-friendly sport. There are three players on each team, with six "chukkers" (or periods of play) within each match. Learn more at GladiatorPolo.com.

EVENTING



GLADIATOR POLO™



REINING

Reining originates from the working movements of horses and riders when herding cattle and is a judged event designed to show the athletic ability of ranch-type horses in an arena setting. With large fast circles, flying lead changes, 360-degree spins and sliding stops all required within individual performances, Reining is one of the only Western disciplines featured at TIEC on an annual basis.

FEI

Fédération Équestrian Internationale (FEI) is based in Lausanne, Switzerland and is the governing body for all Olympic equestrian disciplines.
