REGISTRATION: Registration opens Monday, April 1, 2024, for all former champions. All other amateurs requesting to participate may register beginning Monday April 15, 2024, at 9:00 am. Deadline to register is Thursday, May 17, 2024, at noon. (12:00 pm)

FORMAT: 36-hole individual stroke play, the players with the lowest total score will be crowned the winner.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Residents & Members of Golf Clubs in Rutherford County that hold an amateur status no later than May 18, 2024. (Including Meadowbrook Golf Club Members and Former Rutherford County Champions that are amateurs.)

ENTRY FEE: Past Champions- \$100, Amateurs - \$125 per player. Includes 2 rounds (36 holes) of golf with shared golf cart, use of practice facilities, Saturday & Sunday continental breakfast, Sunday awards luncheon, tee prizes and more. The tournament committee reserves the right to refuse any application. Final payouts will be based on participation within each flight.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Practice Round - \$30 for registered participants only (valid 1 time).

TEE TIMES/PAIRINGS:

Round 1 pairing done by Tournament Staff. Round 2 pairings will be based on Round 1 scores within your flight.

ATTIRE: Golf Attire is a must for play & practice. Polo-style shirts are a must, microfiber or khaki-type pants, shorts are recommended. Ladies may wear skirts or skorts with a length between their mid-thigh and the kneecaps. Cleghorn is a "soft spike" facility.

CADDIES, WALKING & SPECTATORS: The use of a caddie or walking is not permitted for this event. All golfers must share a golf cart for this event. Spectators may walk but must remain on the cart path at all times.
